

FEASTS OF THE LORD

Feasts are both historical and prophetic.

Leviticus 23

Spring feasts - Passover (Pesach), Unleavened Bread, First Fruits

Month of Nissan - Nissan is the Babylonian name, Abib is the Cananite name

PASSOVER - Exodus 12 and Leviticus 23

Exodus 12: 3-6 On the 10th of Nissan, take a lamb and examine it for four days. On the 14th day, slaughter the lamb. Matthew 21 - Jesus triumphal entry into Jerusalem - on the 14th of Nissan crucified. Exodus 12: 13 & 23 see the blood - pass over

Exodus 12: 46 no bones broken - John 19:36

Exodus 12: 8-11 - instruction on how to eat meal

Jewish observance — — Passover Seder (order)
Remembers God's miracle in freeing His people
Exodus 12: 15 - household cleansed

Passover Seder started with woman lighting the candles and praying over the candles. During the meal, four cups of wine are consumed: cup of sanctification, cup of plagues, cup of redemption and cup of completion or praise.

Matzo tosh - made of three compartments. By tradition - removes middle matzah, breaks in half, wraps in white linen called afikomen (that which comes after), father hides. Later in the meal - children find the afikomen, father buys it back because great is the reward for he who finds the hidden afikomen.
