These quotes refer to Tanakh:

—John 5:39 "These are the scriptures that testify about me."

—II Timothy 3:16 All scripture is God breathed.

—Galatians 3:8 Scriptures foresaw that God would justify Gentiles by faith.

COVENANTS

Two types of covenants—conditional & unconditional. A conditional covenant is bilateral. Both parties agree to the terms of the covenant.

An unconditional covenant is unilateral. Only one party agrees to the terms of the covenant.

The Abrahamic covenant is an unconditional covenant—Gen 15 & it is also an everlasting covenant.

The Abrahamic covenant promises a land, a seed & an everlasting relationship with God. Gen 12, 15 & 17.

The Mosaic covenant is a conditional covenant, both parties agreed to terms. Ex 19:18.

Jer 31:31 the new covenant will be made with Israel & will replace the Mosaic covenant.

There were different types of covenants, for example salt covenants, shoe covenants but the most solemn of all the covenants was the blood covenant
