

MENTORING PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT
Parker Evangelical Presbyterian Church

We have discussed the ways in which we will work together and collaborate in a spirit of partnership. To ensure that our relationship is a mutually rewarding and satisfying experience for both of us, we agree to:

1. Meet regularly

- We will meet twice a month for an hour to an hour-and-a-half
- Spend approximately 45-60 minutes reading and discussing God’s Word

2. Maintain confidentiality in our relationship

- Confidentiality for us means that what we discuss remains between us
- Mentor and mentee will agree ahead of time if specific information is to be shared with anyone else, unless mentor believes the mentee might harm himself or others

3. Honor the ground rules we have developed for the relationship

Our ground rules will be:

- Pray together for each other’s needs
- At the conclusion of each meeting, we will target topics of discussion for our next session
- It is the mentee’s responsibility to confirm the date, time, and location of the next meeting

4. Provide regular feedback to each other and evaluate progress

We agree to meet regularly for 12-months, or until we have accomplished our objectives. At the end of this period of time, we will evaluate our progress and reach a learning conclusion.

If we decide to conclude our mentoring partnership, we agree to use closure to celebrate what we have learned in our time together and we will do so in a Christ-like manner which honors God and each other. We will remain open to resume meeting if desired.
